

Notes St. John Neumann Parish Council Meeting

October 17, 2017

School: St. John the Baptist School has an enrollment of 399 students with 49 coming from St. John Neumann parish. Special Persons Day (formerly Grandparent's Day) will take place on October 20.

Financial: We are in satisfactory financial shape at this time. Of the approximately 825 families on the parish books, only about 210 families make a regular financial contribution to the parish.

Youth Ministry: The high school students attended a meeting that addressed the issue of depression and suicide in teens.

Faith Formation: Plans are being finalized for a new form of religious education for our public school students.

Council Elections: Nominees' pictures and bio information will be available the weekend of October 28/29. Voting will take place the weekend of November 4/5. Council members will be in the gathering space after Mass to collect the ballots.

Advent: A simple soup supper will take place on December 5 at SJN. Taize prayer will follow in the church.

St. John Neumann Feast Day: This celebration will take place on January 20th after the 5:00 p.m. Mass. This is also the 40th anniversary of our parish so there are plans to make this an extra special event.
